Effective July 1, 2023, the following revisions to NRS 641C will be implemented:

- Licensed Clinical Alcohol and Drug Counselor Supervisors (LCADCs) may supervise problem gambling counselor interns, provided that the licensed clinical alcohol and drug counselor fulfills the following criteria and submits an application to the Nevada Board of Examiners for Alcohol, Drug and Gambling Counselors to become an approved Supervisor for Certified Problem Gambling Interns:
  1. The LCADC must be approved by the Board to engage in supervision.
  2. LCADC candidates are required to complete a minimum of 12 hours of Supervision Coursework, to include topics relevant to the supervision of CPCG-I's.
  3. Successfully complete a minimum of 30 hours of instruction specific to problem gambling.

Instructions to apply for an LCADC Supervisor license to supervise Certified Problem Gambling

1. Complete 12 hours of the required Clinical Supervision Coursework and be a supervisor in good standing with the Nevada Board of Examiners for Alcohol, Drug and Gambling Interns.
2. Complete CASAT 30-hour self-paced *Problem Gambling Counselor Foundations* course no more than 6 months prior to submitting an application. 3. Login to [Licensee Portal](#) (NOT Application Portal). This is the one application that is in the Licensee Portal since only current licensees can apply.
4. On the left-hand side of the page click Supervisor Application.
5. Upload Initial Clinical Supervisor Training certificate(s).
6. Pay \$60 fee and submit.
